This next term we will be focusing on specific areas within the EYFS curriculum, we will be discussing different shapes and other objects, looking at their properties, size and weight. We will be using 2.D and 3.D shapes, weighing scales and natural resources to sequence. We will be providing lots

of opportunity for children to build their own role play scenarios, in our home corner, allowing them to build their imaginative skills and create their own narratives.

We will be providing lots of new and exciting activities where children will be encouraged to manage risk and challenge, discuss safety, and think about how we store and transport equipment.

We will be continuing with our holiday theme during the first week of term, children's interests have then led us to look into space, exploring planets, stars and rockets. We will be having a wedding themed week, making dresses from materials, making hats and crowns and having a walk up to church to have a pretend wedding.
